After many weeks of penitential preparation, we celebrate the defeat of sin and death and the victory of love. We use the word "Alleluia" for the first time since Lent began in order to celebrate and participate in that victory. In the Gospel of John, (Read Easter Sunday), only one woman goes to the tomb on the morning of the resurrection: Mary Magdala. She represents the Church who is seeking her savior. She is the first to give witness to the resurrection. Although when Peter and John run to the tomb and John arrives first. because he was running with his heart, he waited to enter because love bows to authority, represented by Peter. Today we all run to the tomb to give witness to the Resurrection of Jesus, Our Lord and Our God!
